Re: DENDRITE CLINICAL SYSTEMS LIMITED

As Regional Director of Cancer Services in Southwest Dublin, and based at St. James's Hospital and Trinity College Dublin, I sought to establish prospective cancer data-bases for all 16 tumour sites managed in three major hospitals in the region, the principal centre being at St. James's Hospital. I worked with Peter Walton and the Dendrite team to this end. We provided a 5-year audit report in 2006, and are currently preparing a 10 year report. Our data-bases are used now by several major hospitals nationally, and Dendrite has played a major role in developing registries within the new national cancer control programme (NCCP). In 2011 we developed a Barrett's Registry with Dendrite which is now live, and provides clinical data from the principal centres in Ireland, as well as data on bioresourced material which is of immense value for clinical and scientific research.

My own personal dealings with Peter Walton and his team of programmers and analysts has always been very positive, most professional, and the recent combined effort to create the web-based Barrett's Registry required an enormous amount of expert input from Dendrite. This centre will introduce shortly a web based registry for oesophageal and gastric cancer, and I would anticipate that all the registries will be web-based in the near future.
